



7. **ALL STUDENT LEADERSHIP MEETINGS AND ACTIVITIES ARE MANDATORY.** Except for rare circumstances like sickness or travel, you need to be at the meetings and activities, ON TIME. Please do not apply for Student Leadership if sports or other activities will prevent you from being faithful to this commitment (we understand there may be some good, valid, parent approved, sparse reasons for missing). You may need to make a choice. Being in Student Leadership will create for you meaningful and purposeful memories, as well as provide you with training that will equip you for college, work, and/or life. If you have to say “no” to something else, it is a worthy sacrifice. Being in Student Leadership is a unique and rewarding training opportunity that needs to be given a high priority in your life and schedules.

8. **STUDENT LEADERS MUST BE REGULARLY INVOLVED IN THEIR RESPECTIVE MINISTRY.** Part of being a leader is being nurtured and challenged in your own faith. Plus, leaders must show others that they care deeply about their own spiritual development. Therefore, 6th – 8th grade student leaders must be regular attendees of Target, and 9th – 12th grade student leaders must be regular attendees of 24Seven.
